Dakota Medical Foundation (DMF) and Impact Foundation began Giving Hearts Day in 2008, mostly for the eastern part of ND and western MN. First of all, DMF and Impact Foundation have as their mission to build a website of non-profit entities that serve in North Dakota and western Minnesota—a sort of one-stop shopping site to connect donors with regional non-profits in service to the area. The site is up all year (www.impactgiveback.org) but Giving Hearts Day seeks to inspire people to give to worthy organizations and makes it easy to give more by offering matching funds.

This year Sacred Heart Benedictine Foundation was invited to participate with a membership-cost waiver for 2014 (what a gift!). Other notable non-profits who have joined from western North Dakota include Badlands Ministry, Best Friends Mentoring Program, Dickinson Public School Backpack Program, Dickinson State University, Home on the Range, House of Manna, and St. Luke's Foundation. We have joined the great company of non-profits which include Catholic Charities, St. Gianna's Maternity Home, Presentation Prayer Center, etc. If you have never given online, this is definitely the safe place to start! If you have given online before, this is definitely a site to bookmark.

Since the site's beginning in 2008, giving has grown every year. Last year, with matching funds, the non-profits raised \$1,060,715! Giving Hearts Day, February 13, is a great day for giving "with a boost," but it must be a credit card donation online for us to get the matching funds.

As you are well aware, we believe in the power of prayer. We appreciate it when people call or write us with their prayer needs because it is one of our major offerings as monastic women. Years ago we had some lovely 3" x 3" cobalt blue votive candle holders crafted that are etched with the Monastery bell tower logo.

For the last couple of years we have offered these prayer candles to you as a way to remember a loved one, honor a deserving person, anticipate a newborn, or pray for a special intention. Perhaps you know someone who is suffering the loss of a loved one, dealing with family problems, suffering with illness, struggling to earn a living, or is simply in need of the power prayer can wield. For a donation of \$100 or more, a votive candle will be identified with your named intention and set in our sanctuary and lit every Saturday evening for First Vespers throughout Lent and Easter 2014. We are visually reminded to pray for your intentions at our Divine Office and Eucharist.

When the Easter season ends, we send you the "wellused" votive candle holder so that you can continue the prayers for your intention. It is an exquisite holder that serves as a beautiful reminder of the power of prayer.
